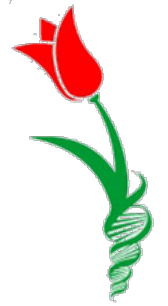

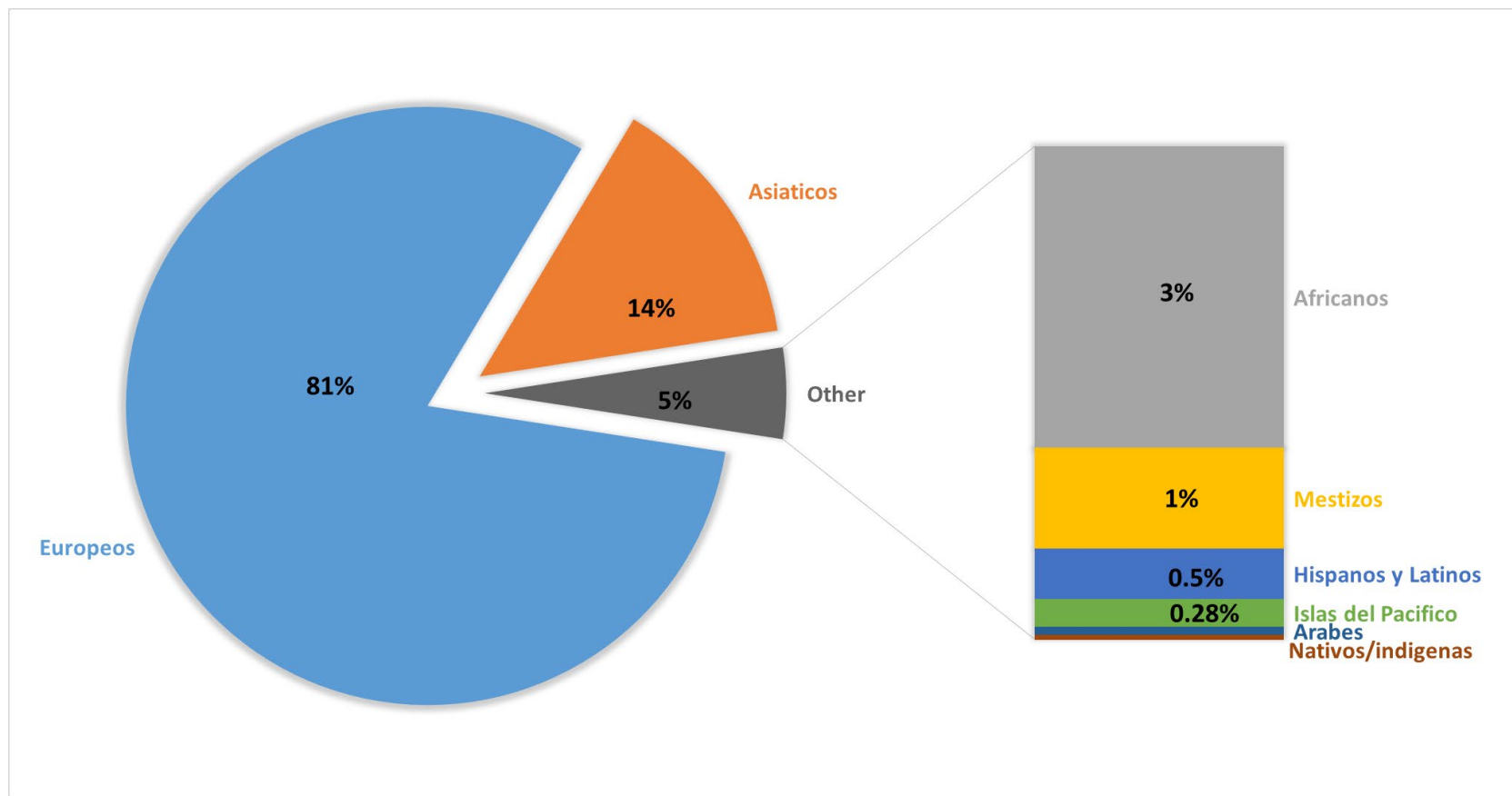

Representation of Hispanics in the two largest trials for PD



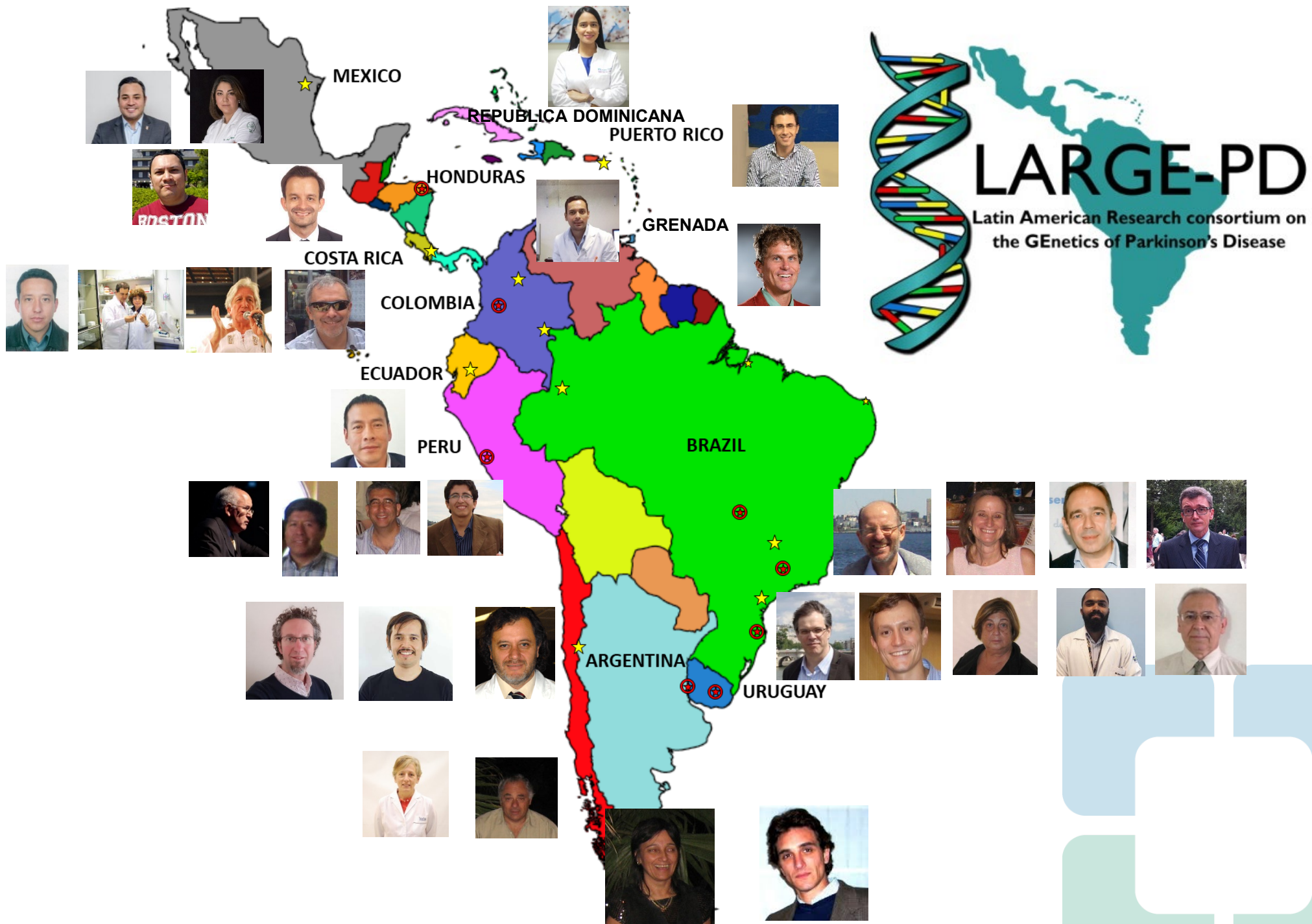

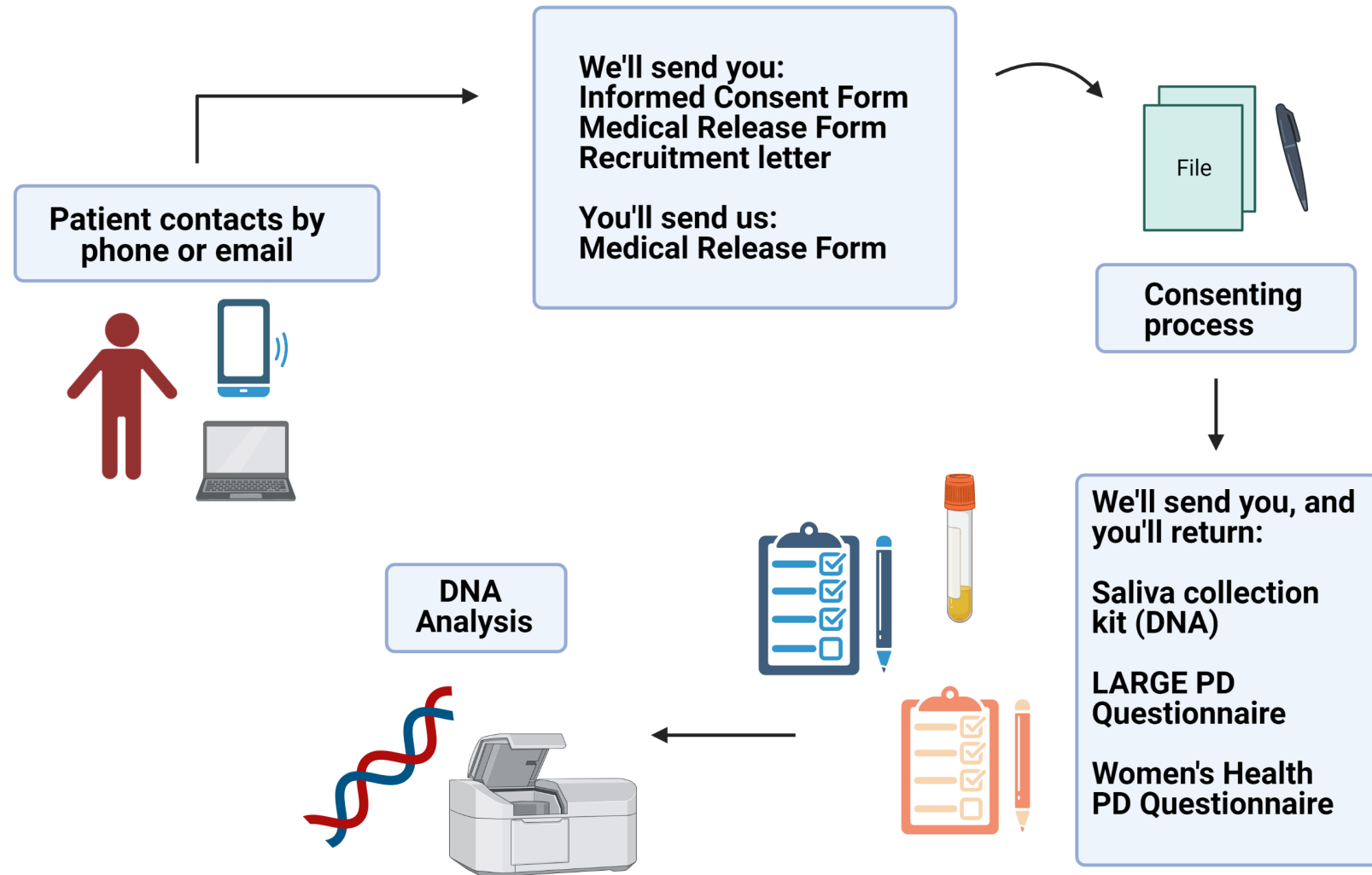
